4.3. Edge Stitch

Ornament applied to the front side of the workpiece is called stitching to the edge stitch, at a distance of 2mm parallel to a finished joint seam line. A row is sewn from the surface of the fabric in parallel to a finished seam line and formed by a row of straight seams. Sewing is sewn 1-2 mm from the edge. It is usually applied for ornamenting purposes.

The fabric is made of flat stitches by folding 1-2 mm. When the fabric is opened, the ornamental stitch is sewn to the stitch.
