3.1.6.3 Friction Strength

The friction strength of polyester yarn is 7 to 10 times higher than the same thickness cotton yarn.

- High friction strength:
- To be able to withstand long periods of stitching under heavy movement and load,
- Ornamental stitches and marrows remain in the same way for long periods of wear and many times washing,
- It minimizes the loss of solidity during the sewing process and ensures the best stitch quality with the first strength of the yarn,
